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Introduction

Log History provides a convenient preview of the recent Administrator Event Log events. Events are shown either in individual data text fields arranged in a grid or in a single text box. Configurable severity and category filters allow users to select which types of events to monitor.



Properties

History Length

an integer that specifies the number of recent events to display and determines the number of controls shown in the grid.



Controls

Severity Normal

a toggle button that allows events of a “normal” severity level to be captured

Severity Error

a toggle button that allows events of an “error” severity level to be captured

Category Filters

toggle buttons that select which events should be captured based on the enabled criteria. Options include:

- Connect
- Control
- Hardware
- Paging
- Schedule
- Security
- System
- User

Clear

a trigger button that clears the history output of the plugin. This does not affect the actual system log file.

Date, Severity, Category, Source, Message

textbox controls that display the relevant event data. The top row (Row 1) is the most recent event. The number of events displayed is determined by the “History Length” property.

Text

a simplified text view of the historical events. Event data is concatenated and presented as individual lines. The number of events to show is determined by the “History Length” property.
